

2008 GRAF RINK TINY TOTS – SPRING ICE

SNOW POLICY:

**If the Newburyport school district is closed there will be no Tiny Tots class.
If there is a delayed opening in the Newburyport school district class will take place as usual.**

Applications are taken on a first come basis and only until space no longer permits. Spaces are not automatically held from the last series. Confirmation calls will not be made. Please note our refund policy below. Your checks will not be cashed until 1 week before the scheduled start date of class. At no point in time should you leave your child unattended at the rink. Parents must remain on rink grounds during the entire class. Should you have to leave the rink please make sure to assign another parent to be in charge of your child in case of an emergency or needed trip to the bathroom. \$108/skater for the 8-week class.

Each class consists of a 5-minute warm-up, a 30-minute lesson and concludes with a 15-minute game involving all skaters. Your payment is due in full with your registration. \$25.00 of your payment is non-refundable and pro-rated refunds will only be available if the Skating Director is notified of your withdrawal prior to the start of the 3rd class of the series. If your skater has aged out of the Tots program there is a Basic Skills program run by the Graf Rink as well. Basic Skills classes meet on Tuesday and Thursday from 6-6:50pm during the spring. There are also a limited number of Tiny Tots spaces during these classes for parents that can't make the above classes. REQUIREMENTS

Children must be at least 3 years old and have a 50-minute attention span. No double-blade skates are allowed. Gloves or mittens, snowsuits and warm clothes are necessary. Helmets must be worn. Hockey helmets are strongly recommended however a bike helmet is acceptable as long as it fits tight to the head. New adult skaters in the Mom and Tots program are encouraged to wear helmets as well. Parents must stay in the lobby or in the bleachers inside the rink if not taking a class. At no point in time should parents be in front of the boards inside the rink. Parents are not allowed on the ice with the children unless participating in the Mom and Tots program. Skaters are asked to be on time as late arrivals disrupt class. Parents are expected to remain on rink grounds during Tiny Tots classes. If you need to leave however, we ask that you place another parent in charge of your child and notify the instructors that you will be leaving.

EQUIPMENT

Double runner blades are not allowed. Skates may be rented at a discount price of \$3 during our Tiny Tots classes. We strongly recommend using figure skates when learning how to skate for the first time. "Skate-Aides" (red bars) are provided by the rink should a new skater need the additional support on the ice. Instructors will distribute the Skate-Aides when necessary and will be used at their discretion. Helmets must be worn. Skaters should be dressed warm and hands should be protected with gloves or mittens. Elbow and knee pads are not recommended since they limit mobility. The Graf Rink sells excellent beginner figure skates at reasonable prices. Please visit the Pro-Shop inside the rink lobby for more information. Tights, gloves, skating outfits and other fun skating supplies may also be purchased in the Pro-Shop.

There will be no refunds or make-ups given due to your own cancellations or conflicts. Only medical and family emergency refunds will be given. A doctor's note must be provided for a medical refund.
